

1. BRIEF HISTORY, GENESIS, MISSION & VISION

> BRIEF HISTORY

The Kamalnishtha Sansthan, dedicated to expansion of education and rural development, is situated at Kolsia in Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan. Kolsia is a representative village of the Shekhawati Region, countrywide known for rich cultural and artistic heritage, leading business groups of the country, military services, rural education and upliftment. The Sansthan was established in 1997 and we feel pleasure to inform you that we have succeeded in achieving our targets so far because of the scholarly guidance and supervision of our learned Patrons and the Board of Advisors.

Since 1997, the Kamalnishtha Sansthan has been imparting remarkable and valuable services in the field of education, social awakening, agriculture and various progressive schemes. We feel highly pleased to put it to your kind notice and consideration that the Kamalnishtha Sansthan has been involved in various welfare and development activities in rural areas around Kolsia. A brief account of the major activities is as under –

> GENESIS

KAMALNISHTHA SANSTHAN is a community based organization in the voluntary sector, working directly with poor and marginalized. We are registered under Rajasthan Societies Registration Act of 1958, 80 FCRA and Disable Persons Act 52 92) of 1995. KN is also exempted under section 12A and 80G-5(F) of Indian Income Tax Act. Our strategic focus is to create enabling environment in which people have access to opportunities – to maximize their potential, to participate actively in the development process and shape the present and future of their communities and country.

The Institute strives for excellence in Education and Rural Technology; New Advances in Vocational Applications; Legal Matters concerning Intellectual Property, environmental & agricultural betterment, consumer protection, civil

rights, social evil eradication, disable persons welfare activities, RCH activities, SHG training, research & development, de-addiction, employment oriented activities, bio control laboratory, Senior citizen's house, drinking water purity, small scale industries promotion etc; and Information, including technology source, consultancy, institutions, collaborations, case studies, etc.

> MISSION

To provide a platform for all concerned with sustainable development to catalyze the Process of human development.

> VISION

KAMALNISHTHA SANSTHAN adopts the new technology and philosophy in the age of modern scientific development in the sake of well being of the society and humanity. At present day scenario the people needs the assurance and confidence that the voluntary organization has the ability to provide the facilitation or ways consistently to the defined goal of life. A voluntary organization needs to have a sound knowledge base of the society and development pedagogy, should have the right attitudes and commitments and also should able to achieve the socio-cultural goals in a variety of contexts of which the VO would work in future.

To fulfill the above expectations KN make quality and defining element of social welfare through a combination of self and external commitments for unending enthusiasm and devotion to quality improvement for sustainable development.

2. APPROACH OF THE ORGANIZATION

The organization has dedicated and enthusiastic workers. In new area, the organization places trained and experienced persons, who start the activities with assessment of local resources. Village entry level programme is carried out with active participation of people who are associated in total decision making process. Through village entry level programme, problems of people are derived and analysis of local untapped resources helps in solution of the problems faced by the people. Participatory rural appraisal is also carried with active participation of the people where problems and prospects of activities are analyzed in detail.

People of the area are associated in different activities as per their perceived demands and wages. Training for capacity building is an essential component and all the interested persons under different activities are mobilized in two various groups where they are encouraged to start thrift and credit activities. The organization empowers people to take decisions in their own interest and performs role of facilitator in the lacking areas. Sustenance of formed groups is evaluated through functionaries and further course of activities is started as per requirement with this process, people develop feelings of ownership within the groups and activities. Groups are encouraged to record proceedings of their meeting and group members are encouraged to select or elect their group chairman and group functionaries.

3. OBJECTIVES OF THE ORGANISATION

The organization was established for attainment of objectives of awareness generation in the people about the literacy, health and downtrodden people of the rural and urban society. Women is the main focus of the objective for imparting honorable position of society by creating an environment for eradication of social, economic and physical violence, providing equal status in the society and strengthen them through capacity building, empowerment in decision making process in family, society and development activities. Focused objectives of the organization are as under:

- 1. Extension of educational and health services.
- 2. To encourage women and child development programmes.
- 3. To make efforts for land conservation and environment preservation.

- 4. To make efforts to preserve historical and cultural heritage.
- 5. To make efforts for social awareness.
- 6. To encourage productivity oriented economic programmes for sustainable development.
- 7. To develop mass opinion for solving universal problems.
- 8. To adapt suitable means for propagation and spreading of education in general, physical education, women's education, Non-formal education, alternative education, continuing education, employment-oriented education, technical education, teacher's training, adult-education, nutrition education etc.
- 9. To establish and run educational institution, crèches, Anganwadi and other training centers for spreading education and to make efforts for making available cheaper text books, audio-visuals and other materials.
- 10. To make efforts for socialization of education residential primary education and for improving the standard of education.
- 11. To conduct sports programmes for physical development and to establish and run a sports complex.
- 12. To educate people about de-addiction and start a de-addiction centre for treatment of the addicts.
- 13. To encourage cleanliness in village and use of clean drinking water and establish multipurpose service centres for village development.
- 14. To make arrangements for citizenship education and to educate people in this regard for citizen's awareness and for awakening the village representatives to develop leadership quality.
- 15. To undertake necessary agricultural activities and training to educate the farmers about the fertilizers and chemicals used for agriculture.

- 16. To conduct different activities for the welfare of youth, such as youth clubs, youth centres and conducting excursions, seminars and youth exchange programmes.
- 17. To make efforts for the educational, social economic, cultural uplifting of orphans, helpless, old, handicapped, backward and deprived persons and to arrange for their rehabilitation by establishing shelter homes.
- 18. To organise deliberations, lectures, conferences, meetings, workshops to consider solutions for eliminating the universally faced social, economic, educational, cultural, political, philosophical, moral, healthrelated, environmental and other problems and to publish and circulate the results thereof as may be necessary.
- 19. To have networking with such other organizations, institutions and societies whose objectives are similar to that of Kamalnishtha Sansthan and to associate with them as may be necessary.

4. REGISTRATION, RECOGNITION AND APPROVAL

> SOCIETY REGISTRATION



The Sansthan was registered as a non-profit society under the Rajasthan Societies Registration Act of 1958 and Certificate of Registration was obtained on 28th February, 1997. The Certificate of Registration issued by the Registrar of Societies, Assistant Registrar office, Jhunjhunu bears the number: **Jhu/156/1997-98**.

> INCOME TAX ACT

The Sansthan had approached the Department of Income tax, Ministry of Finance to obtain approval under Section 80(G), 12 (A) of Income Tax Act so that all financial contributions to Institute are eligible for Tax exemption

under the Income Tax Act. The Department of Income Tax had issued the approval and the approval was valid up to Life time.

> FCRA

The Sansthan had been granted recognition by the Ministry of Home Affairs, GOI, under Foreign Contribution Regulation Act from 13th October 2004 with **FCRA registration no. 12562008/13-10-2004.**

DISABILITY ACT

The Kamalnishtha Sansthan was also registered as a Disable Persons welfare society under the Disable Persons by Department of Social Justice & Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur and Registration was obtained on 15th June, 2009.

The Certificate of Registration issued by the Commissioner (Disability) Rajasthan, Jaipur bears the number: 253/Jaipur/2009-2010.

5. DEPARTMENTS > KAMALVANI COMMUNITY RADIO STATION (FM)



Kamalnishtha Sansthan has been started a community radio station (FM) KAMALVANI 90.4 FM with a license from Ministry of Information & Broadcasting, Government of India, New Delhi on 22nd November, 2012. KAMALVANI advocates for peace, social and environmental justice through independent media and programming neglected by the mainstream. We embrace diversity, tolerance of others' opinions and freedom of expression. KAMALVANI celebrates and promotes the creative, cultural and educational vitality of the local community.

KAMALVANI is committed to the values expressed by her mission, especially as they relate to issues involving the various ethnic groups living in our community, women, the economically disadvantaged or challenged, and other groups who may be disenfranchised in our society. KAMALNISHTHA VIDYA NIKETAN, KOLSIA (+2 LEVEL)

Our basic motto is that every child is in school and learning well. In this sake of well being Kamalnishtha Vidya Niketan has been established on March 21, 1997 as a primary school in the midst of village Kolsia. Afterwards in 1998 it was promoted into middle school and since 2003 it has been imparting its services as secondary school. The Sansthan has been providing formal and regular education on headquarter of the institute from beginning time The school provides computer education free cost to her students. Keeping in mind the need of the students of this area, Drawing, home-Science & Agriculture Science are taught in Senior Secondary with other subjects of Science & Arts.

RURAL CHILDREN LIBRARY

The Sansthan had a view to develop interest in reading among the children, a library with children's books was established and Prof.N.K.Ambasht, Chairman, National Institute of Open Schooling, New Delhi, inaugurated it. Quite a good number (7105) of books have been procured from different sources and the village children with great interest are using the library. Late. Dr. Sahib Singh Ji Verma, Former Union Labor Minister visited the Sansthan on 20th May, 2003 and contributed so many books, racks, library furniture for this library. The main areas covered in the library are – Rural Development, Education, Agriculture, Economics, History, Sociology, Geography, Science & mathematics, Management, Information Technology and Computer Science, Children Section, Home Science.

> KN-SPEECH (RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT)

First edition of KN SPEECH was published on Oct.1, 2006. It is an Environmental, Educational, Cultural and Health magazine. This journal will cover all aspects of environment like air, water, soil, noise, solid waste, biomedical waste management and its control, industrial hygiene, environment laws etc.

With a view to achieve the objective of the organization, Kamalnishtha Sansthan has developed three-tier system of Education, Research and Extension. The Sansthan has established separate unit KN-SPEECH for research activities. During the year, the unit of the organization has carried research activities in various spheres with its own support. Important and notable activities carried out during the year are detailed below -

💐 FLY-ASH MANAGEMENT

Thermal energy generation units exhaust huge quantity of fly-ash, which is quite problematic from its appropriate point of view. The Sansthan is well aware of the country problem as there are many thermal energy generation units functional in the country and disposal of fly-ash is quite serious problem. Usually one rack of coal is consumed per day per thermal unit and the fly-ash exhausted is serious problem to the authorities, who want easy solution for its disposal. Sansthan Research Unit has developed technology, which is presently under testing for its rationale use and also helping the authorities. The research outcome are quite encouraging and it has been decided to prepare proposal for productive of fly-ash which is presently waste material causing serious environmental problems in disposal.

WATER SAVING DEVICES

The organization is well aware of ground water depletion problems especially in desert areas where ground water has reached at the critical stage due to over-exploitation of ground water resources. Almost most of the desert districts are at critical stage converted into dark zone where further ground water depletion will cause serious consequences. One of such research scheme of water saving device in crop cultivation through bio-fertilizer use is at the final stage of testing provided quite encouraging results.

Tree and vegetation is quite critical in the Thar desert, where chances of survival of trees are quite dim. Various programmes of state have been failed to get success. The research unit of Sansthan has carried out research for increasing live rate of tree plantation in critical water conditions. The outcome of the research is at final stage of examination and its application would be initiated in fields. It is worth reporting that desert people understand importance of water and tree, which witnesses their interest in environment. Cutting live tree is disliked by local people and try to discourage such efforts.

RETENTION OF NATURAL SOIL FERTILITY

With increasing use of chemical fertilizers and chemical pesticides, the natural fertility of the soil has been vanished and for maintaining productivity level, the cultivators are compelled to use higher quantity of chemical fertilizers and pesticides. Cultivated areas of the state need more water for crop growth. Sansthan has carried out research to maintain natural soil fertility within a period of four years in phased manner in any cultivated field where natural soil fertility has been vanished completely. The preliminary results of research are quite encouraging and the organization is hopeful to treat the soil.

6. SPECIALIST SUPPORT AND OFFICIALS

The organization has a long list of 47 specialists in the fields of health & hygiene, education, environment, agronomy, soil science, bio-technology and social sciences whose services are taken on turnkey basis for the requisite duration. 96 volunteers are also associated who work for the requisite duration in awareness generation campaigns and help the organization in achieving the laid down objectives.

7. OFFICE AND EQUIPMENTS

Registered office of the organization is located in village Kolsia Panchayat Nawalgarh District Jhunjhunu which controls total task of the activities in 11 districts. Decisions for coverage of move villages and the executive body of the organization takes towns in the existing districts and coverage of new districts in view of people's interest.

Office at Kolsia is fully equipped with furniture and fixtures. There are 8 computers with UPS and Inverters, five printers. One Bus, Three jeeps, three Motor Cycles are available in rental accommodation and district functionaries are provided vehicle for access to field areas.

8. ACTIVITIES

> SOCIAL WELFARE ACTIVITIES

SAFE DRINKING WATER

In various parts of state, people are forced to drink impure water causing serious diseases. Problem of fluoride in very serious in Nagaur district causing physical deformity and tooth decay. Fluoride contents are found in excess than the permissible limit of 1.5ppm. Similarly salinity problems are serious parts of the state. In addition, impure water is available in various parts of the state especially in rural areas due to administrative, geographical and social reasons. Though Government has been vigilant to provide safe water to all people but still many areas have serious problem.

During the camps organized by Sansthan, people of the villages were made aware to drink potable water and in case impure water is available, proper safeguards are suggested to the people. For creation of awareness generation among the people, Sansthan has prepared various leaflets, pamphlets, folders etc, which are also distributed in villages.

TRAINING FOR CAPACITY BUILDING/SKILL UPGRADATION

Training is an important tool of implementation programme of various activities. Problem with many of the people in rural and urban areas is lack of skill development, which is a serious barrier in their employment or under-employment. Skill development includes capacity building of people in quality, design, marketing etc. which helps in getting better remuneration in same duration of work. Sansthan organizes training programmes for self-employment and wage employment as both sectors require skill upgradation. During the year 27 training programmes have been carried out successfully in different trades and activities.

INCOME GENERATION ACTIVITIES

Income general activities are carried out by formation of self-help groups where groups of male and female are formed for selfemployment activities. During the year 3 women self help groups have started income generation, where each participating women engaged in tie & dye activity is getting annual income of about Rs. 18000 per year. Kamalnishtha Sansthan has established marketing linkages and these groups have broken the linkages of middlemen, exploiting them by providing less income.

Another 147 self help groups have been formed by the organization are in the preliminary stage where saving of each group has been accumulated ranging between Rs. 300 to 500 as per their inception time. About 48 groups have started thrift and credit activity among group members as part of their sustainability.

ENVIRONMENT DEVELOPMENT

For environment upgradation and development Sansthan has started various activities. Solid waste management has been started during current year and tree plantation in schools and wasteland has started momentum. Environment degradation is the critical issue specially in desert areas, where Sansthan is trying its best to adopt various measures as per the research findings and few are detailed below –

PLANTATION ACTIVITIES

Tree plantation is getting momentum as people started understanding the benefits. Awareness generation created among the target area have yielded encouraging results and cultivators have been encouraged to plant trees and bushes for protection of their fields. Under wasteland lying in many of the villages, trees of fodder and horticulture importance have been raised. Tree plantation with active participation of students in schools campus has been successful and people of localities are also encouraged for plantation of their liked trees. This is impact of awareness generation created in 42 villages during earlier year and 78 villages during the current year.

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

Sansthan has started solid waste management activity through awareness generation, demonstration and training. Ten groups have started preparation of bio-fertilizer from solid from solid waste and another 197 groups have been formed after awareness generation. Demonstration impact of activity under execution has created enthusiasm among the cultivators having livestock.

HEALTH AND HYGIENE

Under health and hygiene sector, awareness generation has yielded encouraging results as people have started adopting preventive measures rather than waiting for using curative measures. Activities taken up during the year are mainly related to women and child development, reproductive child health, family welfare programme, hygiene, HIV/AIDS where awareness generation was the main tool of communication.

WOMEN & CHILD DEVELOPMENT

Awareness general remained the tool of communication in all the 450 villages covered by the organization. The campaign launched cover safe motherhood, pre-natal and post-natal care. Measures for maintaining gap between children and small family norm for maintenance of health of mother and delivering healthy children. Nurturing child at various stages with feeding and vaccination to keep safety from diseases. All these issues were addressed in the campaign drive.

REPRODUCTIVE CHILD HEALTH

Reproductive child health was also included as a component of awareness generation campaign, where would be mothers were communicated to have children as per their desire and not by chance. Child care in a essential task for nurturing till school going age and preparing mother to get another child keeping in view of her physical capability while maintaining significant gap between two children.

FAMILY WELFARE PROGRAMME

Small family norm is the necessity of time in view of family prosperity and associating in the national programme to check population growth trends. For having small family short term and permanent measures were communicated to male and female members of the families. Preventive measures for avoiding children while nurturing earlier child was communicated in sophisticated manner, Permanent measures to stop children and various misleading concept over the impact on physical system of male and female were communicated, The organization is happy with the significant decline in growth of 30.61 percent during 1981-91 to 20-9 percent in 1991-2001.

CHILDREN WELFARE PROGRAMME

As part of responsibility for participation in national programmes, Kamalnishtha Sansthan participated in child health care by providing preventive oral pills to all children between 0-5 age group. The parents of children made aware about the necessity of timely vaccination of children to avoid unpleasant consequences. The impact of awareness generation was overwhelming and people are now careful to adopt the medical advice in the best of interest of their loving children.

💐 HIV/AIDS

HIV/AIDS is a very serious disease with no permanent cure for eradication of the problem. The organization has been creating awareness in the people to restrict their physical interactions with the legal counterpart. Since this issue is quite critical and extra-martial relations are inevitable in the society, adoption of preventive measures is the only mode for safety from further spread of the problem and infection of the persons to due to unsafe interaction. The awareness campaign was quite encouraging as male and female members of the understand the delicacy in free interaction.

WATER HARVESTING

The desert areas in the Jhunjhunu district in Rajasthan have been very badly affected by the situation of serious drought and famine in every alternative year. People have faced a series of famine in the period from 1998 to 2002 continually and after that also alternatively in the block of Nawalgarh and Udaipurwati.

The project areas taken up by the organisation is the villages of Nawalgarh and Udaipurwati Panchayat Samiti of Jhunjhunu district. CAPART, Jaipur had sanctioned Roof Top Water Harvesting Tanka Project to Kamalnishtha Sansthan. Soon after sanction of the project, Kamalnishtha Sansthan started mobilization of beneficiaries. Though list of 100 families communicated to CAPART had given their acceptance after process of awareness generation.

SERVICES OF HANDICAPPED PERSONS



The Kamalnishtha Sansthan is engaged to serve handicapped (disabled) persons from starting of the institute to fulfill the objectives. The institute is extending her helping hands to the persons who are physically and mentally disabled persons. The following activities are being conducting by the institute in this area.

DISABLE PERSONS VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME



Kamalnishtha Sansthan started mobilization of beneficiaries. Training task has been completed within two years from starting date of the project.

Dignitaries of the area and experts of the field visited training sites and given the blessing to group men-women for successfully running the activities after completion of training programme.

FREE OF COST EDUCATION



The Institute provided free of cost education to Institute the disabled students who are studying in the sister concerned schools. Now, twenty-five students are benefiting in this year (sessions).

MEDICAL FACILITY

Various types of medical facilities are being provided to the people of this rural area. Such as periodical medical check-up, vaccination, magic show, rural dramas, free supply of children's books, etc.

Magazine State Sta

Village level camps were organised to educate the villagers about ill effects of the various modes of addiction through deliberative efforts. One time supply of the medicines prescribed for individual addicts was also provided cost free. More than 50 addicts benefited from these camps.

SOCIAL EVILS ERADICATION

Many evil social practices adversely affecting the socio-economic conditions of the villagers prevail in the region, such as dowry system, Nukta indebtedness, child marriage, death feast etc. which leave a direct social and economic impact on the sufferer. IEC methods were adopted to educate the people in this direction.

EMPLOYMENT-ORIENTED ACTIVITIES

This is a institution's permanent programme, which is continued with own meager resources and without any financial support from outside, the organisation had undertaken some employment-oriented activities during the year to encourage self-employment attitude among the villagers, which included tailoring, typing, computer basic, carpet weaving. Total 400 women/men benefited from the program and being able to do own job as household work.

CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAM



Government have provided rights to the consumers and trying to enforces various clauses of the Consumer Protection Act, but people of urban and rural areas are still not aware of their rights. Sansthan has made its sincere efforts to create awareness among the

people by citing various example of items and areas where vigilance is essential. Many people are not aware about the areas and functions of Consumer Courts. The efforts made by Sansthan in target area have yielded encouraging results.

WATER CLEANING AND WATER PURITY

Through public meetings, speeches, demonstrations etc. efforts were made to educate the villagers about the importance of the water cleanliness and purity and the steps to be taken locally to gain the same.

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

The concept of open basic education under Non-formal education system of MHRD GOI was cited by Dr.D.P.Singh, Secretary, Kamalnishtha Sansthan. The concept of OBE was introduced in five institutions in the country including Kamalnishtha Sansthan, which is honor to the credibility of Sansthan for dedicated work in the field of quality education.

FORMAL EDUCATION

The Kamalnishtha Sansthan, Kolsia has been providing formal and regular education on the headquarter of the institute from beginning time. There is a facility of quality technical education in this school, keeping in view the need of modern area. Computer laboratory is established for awareness and update information to give to students of rural area. The school provides computer education free cost to her students. Keeping in mind the need of the students of this area, Science, Arts, Drawing, home-Science & Agriculture Science.

COMPUTER LITERACY PROGRAMME

Need of today's academic world Kamalnishtha Sansthan also run computer literacy programme in Jhunjhunu and Jaipur districts of Rajasthan. Sansthan every equipped with computers. Computer education is being dealt with through the Certificate in Computer Education (CCA) of the National Institute of Open Schooling, MHRD, GOI, New Delhi. This year 650 students consulted the program and being literate about basic computing.

GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING PROGRAMME

The Kamalnishtha Sansthan has started a facility of vocational and educational guidance and counseling to the students of this area. There is a tough job for rural students to choose for further studies. A learned and competent counselor has been appointed at the teacher providing guidance and counseling to the students. Its' major objectives are –

- To select the area of the studies,
- To select the institution for further studies,
- To manage the finance for education,
- To give information about vocational training institutions, and
- To help the students in appointment of various vocational institutions

RURAL CHILDREN LIBRARY

With a view to develop interest in reading among the children, a small library with children's books was established and Prof.N.K.Ambasht, Chairman, National Institute of Open Schooling, New Delhi, inaugurated it. Quite a good number of books have been procured from different sources and the village children with great interest are using the library.

💐 RURAL TALENT SEARCH PROGRAM

Like every year Kamalnishtha Sansthan organized different activities were with a view to encourage the talents among the rural children, such as competitions in essay-writing, debate, painting, singing and other cultural and educational activities. The best amongst the competitors were appropriate rewarded on the occasion of the foundation day of the organisation.

SCOUT & GUIDE ACTIVITY

As co-curricular activity Kamalnishtha Sansthan join her hand with the Bharat Scout & Guide activity through the schools, which are managed by him. During the year teachers and students were attended different level scout & guide program and get good achievements.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

RURAL SPORTS AND GAMES

Like every year, sports and games meet was organised for the rural youths from the surrounding villages in which about 220 youths participated. The main items of interest for the rural youths were Kabbaddi, Volleyball, different races and jumps. Suitable prizes were distributed.

> AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES

In Rajasthan economy still target depends on agriculture and the economic upliftment of the area is impossible without the development of agriculture which can be made possible by extending the information of the research work and new techniques of farming, storing and marketing. The Sansthan has rendered her services in the following areas –

WATER MANAGEMENT & SOIL CONSERVATION

During the year KN emphasis was on water management and soil conservation besides new agricultural techniques for which help was taken from the experts from Krishi Vigyan Kendras and other agricultural institutions. More than 250 farmers actively participated and benefited from these efforts of the organisation.

During the year Sansthan has organised the practical demonstrations with the help of agricultural experts to enable the farmers familiar with Organic farming and Vermi Compost.

MEDICINAL PLANTS FARMING


